Guy Gladstone is interested in preparing and distributing a leaflet specifically addressed to public school inmates. He would be glad to hear from others interested in this.

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Alec Taylor proposes that a general meeting should be planned to take place in London - date to be fixed - he suggests during the summer holidays.

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Peter Ford hopes to compile a bibliography or book list relevant to libertarian ideas on education. Suggestions for inclusion (inc. magazine articles with dates of issue) would be gratefully received.

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Arlesey Anarchist Group intend to prepare a leaflet suitable for distribution to trainee-teachers. It is hoped to complete this by the end of May.

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Talks and discussion meetings at Colleges of Education have been considered but there is the problem that teachers are usually at work for the same period as students and therefore it is difficult to arrange meetings. If half-term holidays do not coincide meetings might be possible to arrange. Intending speakers could make contact. Alistair Rattray (Chorley College) and Michael Anthony (Ex- Worcester College) are interested in this idea.

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The proposal for a Teachers Libertarian Association or Alliance was included on the agenda of the recent Anarchist Federation of Britain Conference in Birmingham. The Conference in general supported the idea and groups that expressed a particular interest are included in the address list.

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Birmingham Anarchist Group were, or are, preparing a leaflet for distribution to schools.

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Ilford Libertarian Group will be producing a pamphlet in the not-too-distant future suitable for sale to teachers or students -in-training.

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Reading Anarchist Group have had recent experience of leafletting schools ('Freedom' 29th Jan, '66). The Group are prepared to produce a regular bulletin on 'Freedom in Education' and raise the question of Funds for this project.
